World Changers projects begin on Monday afternoon and conclude the following Saturday morning when groups depart the lodging facility.

AM

- Breakfast
- Crews depart for worksites (crews comprise of 11-14 people and are made up of students and adults from different churches... students will have at least one other person from their church on their crew)
- Ministry Assignments at worksite (roofing, painting, cleanup, etc.)
- Quiet Time at worksite
- Lunch at Site/Crew Devotions

PM

- Continue Ministry Assignment at worksite
- Head for lodging facility - Clean up, Straighten Up, Rest Up
- Dinner at Lodging facility
- Worship
- Youth Group Devotions
- Free Time
